## LOCAL LAW NUMBER 7 - 2018 COUNTY OF CATTARAUGUS, NEW YORK

Pursuant to Section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

## AMENDING LOCAL LAW NUMBER 7-2013 (INTRO NUMBER 6-2013) REGARDING FEE SCHEDULE FOR ONOVILLE MARINA BOATING AND CAMPING ACTIVITIES TO INCLUDE DISABLED VETERANS ACTIVE MILITARY PERSONNEL AND RESERVISTS EXEMPTION

BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature of the County of Cattaraugus as follows:

<u>SECTION 1. Legislative Intent.</u> It is the intent of this Local Law to amend Local Law No. 7-2013 (Intro No. 6-2013), which established the fee schedule for the Onoville Marina boating and camping activities, to exempt disabled veterans, active military personnel and reservists from admission fees into the Onoville Marina.

<u>SECTION 2. Amendment.</u> Local Law No. 7-2013 is hereby amended by adding an exemption under Section 2. Onoville Marina Fees, as follows: After: "Vehicle Access Fee \$4.00 per day", add: "Exemption for Disabled Veterans, active military personnel and reservists (proof required-NYS Lifetime Liberty Pass and/or their Federal America the Beautiful pass)".

<u>SECTION 3. Severability.</u> If any provision of this Local Law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, then such adjudication, shall not effect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the particular provision directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Local Law shall take effect January 1, 2019.
