## Public Invited to Give Opinions, Ideas About Route 417 Corridor in Olean

The public is invited to a workshop Tuesday, June 20 to talk about potential options for Route 417 in the City and Town of Olean and the Town of Allegany.

The congested roadway has been the focus of continuing development. As a result, the New York State Department of Transportation commissioned an access management study of the corridor from 20<sup>th</sup> Street in the City of Olean to the Village of Allegany border. The purpose of the study is to propose solutions to existing and potential traffic problems.

The workshop is scheduled as follows:
