All proposals received are subject to all federal and state controls concerning said item(s).

All proposals must be accompanied by a NON-COLLUSIVE CERTIFICATION. Any proposal submitted without such certification will not be accepted. Any proposal not meeting <u>ALL</u> specifications will not be considered.

The County Legislature reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, to waive any informalities, and to accept the lowest responsible proposal.

INSTRUCTIONS TO PROPOSER

PROPOSAL FORM

Proposal shall be submitted on these Cattaraugus County Proposal forms or proposal will not be considered. Proposal must be typed or printed in ink. Original autograph signatures in ink are required. Facsimile or rubber stamp signatures will not be accepted. All blanks must be filled in with required information or, if no proposal on an item, the designation N/B (no bid).

2. CHANGES

Any change in wording or interlineation by a proposer of the inquiry as published by Cattaraugus County shall be reason to reject the proposal of such proposer, or in the event that such change in the Invitation for proposal is not discovered prior to entering into a contract, to void any contract entered into pursuant to such a proposal.

3. INFORMALITIES

The County may consider informal any proposal not prepared and submitted in accordance with the provisions hereof and may waive any informalities or reject any and all proposals. The contract award will be made to the responsible proposer submitting the lowest acceptable proposal. Conditional proposals will not be accepted.

4. PROPOSAL TIME

Any proposal may be withdrawn prior to the above scheduled time for the opening of proposals, or authorized postponement thereof. Any proposal received after the time specified shall not be considered.

5. INVESTIGATIONS

The County may make such investigations as it deems necessary to determine the ability of the proposer to perform the work, and the proposer shall furnish to the County all such information and data for this purpose as the County may request. The County reserves the right to reject any proposal if the evidence submitted by, or investigation of, such proposer fails to satisfy the County that such proposer is properly qualified to carry out the obligations of the contract and to complete the work contemplated therein.

6. PROPOSAL ENVELOPE

Each proposal must be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly marked as to contents therein, bearing on the outside the name and address of the proposer. If sent by mail, the sealed envelope containing the proposal must be enclosed in another envelope labeled as specified.

NON-COLLUSIVE CERTIFICATION

Non-collusive bidding certification shall be made by each proposer in the form provided and shall be submitted as a part of the proposal. Proposals submit-ted without non-collusive bidding certification will be considered irregular and may be rejected by the County.

8. CONTRACT AWARD

Contract(s) or purchase order(s) will be awarded after due consideration of the suitability of goods and/or services proposed to satisfy these specifications, the total cost of such goods and/or services including all cost elements, and the timeliness of the agreed delivery date.

9. REFERENCES

A list of references for whom the proposer has done work in the past must accompany the bid. If a proposer cannot provide a list of references, including at least one reference located in Western New York, the County reserves the right to require a performance bond in an amount to be determined by the Public Works Committee in a format acceptable to the County Attorney.

10. EXECUTORY CLAUSE

This executory clause shall be a part of any agreement entered into pursuant to this proposal:

It is understood by the parties that this agreement shall be executory only to the extent of the monies available to the County of Cattaraugus and appropriated therefor, and no liability on account thereof shall be incurred by the County beyond the monies available and appropriated for the purpose thereof.

11. DELIVERY SCHEDULE

Failure to meet delivery or completion schedule as per accepted proposal may result in legal action by Cattaraugus County to recover damages.

12. TAXES

No taxes are to be billed to the County. Proposal shall not include any Federal, State, or local excise, sales, transportation, or other tax unless Federal or State law specifically levies such tax on purchases made by a political subdivision. Any applicable taxes from which the County is not exempt shall be listed separately as cost elements, and added into the total net proposal.

13. COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS

The successful proposer shall comply with all laws, rules, regulations and ordinances of the Federal Government, the State of New York and any other political subdivision or regulatory body which may apply to its performance under this contract.

14. **DISCRIMINATION**

The successful proposer agrees:

- (a) that in the hiring of employees for the performance of work under this contract or any subcontract hereunder, no contractor, subcontractor, nor any person acting on behalf of such contractor or subcontractor, shall by reason of race, creed, color, sex or national origin discriminate against any citizen of the State of New York who is qualified and available to perform the work to which the employment relates;
- (b) that no contractor, subcontractor, nor any person on his behalf shall, in any manner, discriminate against or intimidate any employee hired for the performance of work under this contract on account of race, creed, color, sex or national origin;
- (c) that there may be deducted from the amount payable to the contractor by Cattaraugus County under this contract a penalty of fifty dollars for each person for each calendar day during which such person was discriminated against or intimidated in violation of the provisions of the contract;
- (d) that this contract may be canceled or terminated by Cattaraugus County and all monies due or to become due hereunder may be forfeited, for a second or any subsequent violation of the terms or conditions of this section of the contract; and
- (e) the aforesaid provisions of this section covering every contract for or on behalf of Cattaraugus County for the manufacture, sale or distribution of materials, equipment or supplies shall be limited to operations performed within the territorial limits of the State of New York. (N.Y. State Labor Law Article 8 Section 220-e)

15. CONTRACT ASSIGNMENTS

The proposer shall not assign, transfer, sublet, or otherwise dispose of this contract, or of its right, title or interest in the contract, or its power to execute the same, to any other person or corporation without the previous consent, in writing, of the Chairman of the Cattaraugus County Legislature.

16. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Any additional information which proposer desires to add to the proposal shall be written on a separate sheet of paper, attached to and submitted with the formal sealed proposal, to be read at the formal opening.

17. HOLD HARMLESS

The successful proposer to whom the proposal is awarded shall indemnify and hold harmless Cattaraugus County and its agents and employees from and against all claims, damages, losses or causes of action arising out of or resulting from such vendor's performance pursuant to this proposal.

18. PROPOSAL VALIDITY

This proposal is firm and irrevocable for a period of 45 days from the date and time of the proposal opening. If a contract is not awarded within the 45 day period, a proposer to whom the proposal has not been awarded, may withdraw his proposal by serving written notice of his intention to do so upon the Clerk of the County Legislature.

19. CONTRACT INTEREST

No official, or employee of the County, who is authorized in such capacity, and on behalf of the County, to negotiate, make, accept or approve or to take part in negotiating, making, accepting, or approving this contract shall become directly or indirectly interested personally in this contract or in any part hereof. No officer or employee of, or for the County, who is authorized in such capacity, and on behalf of the County, to exercise any supervisory, administrative, or other function, in connection with this contract, shall become directly or indirectly interested personally in this contract or in any part hereof.

20. PRICE IS FIRM

The unit prices proposed shall remain firm, and any other charges proposed shall also remain firm, for work, and/or services described in this proposal in accordance with the detailed specifications for those services. No cost increase shall be charged for any reason whatsoever.

21. PROPOSER AFFIRMATION

In executing this proposal, the proposer affirms that all of the requirements of the specifications are understood and accepted by the proposer, and that the prices quoted include all required materials and services. The undersigned has checked all of the proposal figures, and understands that the County will not be responsible for any errors or omissions on the part of the undersigned in preparing this proposal. Mistakes or errors in the estimates, calculations or preparation of the proposal shall not be grounds for the withdrawal or correction of the proposal. In case of error in extension of prices in the proposal, the unit price will govern.

22. INSURANCE

The (Contractor, Vendor, Etc.) shall secure and maintain, at its own cost and expense, insurance coverage specified in Appendix (A) attached hereto, complying with Classification "(selected on form)", with insurance companies licensed in the State of New York. Cattaraugus County must be named as an additional insured for purposes of coverage, but not for payment of premium. (Contractor, Vendor, Etc.) shall file a certificate of insurance with the Cattaraugus County Risk Manager covering all acts performed by the (Contractor, Vendor, Etc.) prior to performing pursuant to this Agreement or receiving any payment thereunder and shall be responsible for updating the certificate as necessary throughout the term of the Agreement. All certificates of insurance shall provide that Cattaraugus County be given thirty (30) days notice prior to nonrenewal cancellation of these or policies.

Certificate of Insurance shall be furnished by the proposer with its proposal submittal.

23. LITIGATION:

In the event any litigation shall arise from this contract, the laws of the State of New York shall control any litigation, regardless of which party shall institute such action.

24. MUNICIPAL EXTENSION:

The contract if awarded will be to the lowest responsive/responsible bidder(s) in part or in whole who meet(s) all the terms of the specifications. The County guarantees no minimum or maximum purchases or contracts as a result of award of this bid. Cattaraugus County reserves the right to allow all municipal and not for profit organizations authorized under the General Municipal Laws of the State of New York, to purchase any goods (materials and equipment) and/or services awarded as a result of this bid in accordance with the latest amendments to NYS GML 100 through 104 and County Law Section 408-a. However, it is understood that the extension of such contracts are at the discretion of the vendor and the vendor is only bound to the contract between Cattaraugus County and the vendor.

25. WAGE RATES

Construction, reconstruction, or repair contracts for public works facilities are subject to minimum wage rates, as established by the State of New York Department of Labor. The successful bidder on any contract for public works to which the provisions of the New York State Labor Law Article 8 apply agrees that:

- (a) No laborer, workman or mechanic in the employ of the contractor, subcontractor or other person doing or contracting to do the whole or part of the work contemplated by the contract shall be permitted or required to work more than eight hours in any one calendar day or more than five days in any one week except in cases of extraordinary emergency including fire, flood or danger to life or property. (Section 220, subd. 2, N.Y. State Labor Law)
- (b) Each laborer, workman, or mechanic employed by the contractor, subcontractor or other person doing or contracting to do the whole or part of the work contemplated by the contract shall be paid not less than the hourly minimum rate of wage and provided supplements not less than the prevailing supplements as designated by the New York State Industrial Commission.

(Section 220, subd. 3, N.Y. State Labor Law) A schedule of prevailing hourly wage rates is attached to this packet.

MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS FOR PEST CONTROL SERVICES

- 1. It is the intent of these specifications to describe the need of Cattaraugus County for pest control service at various County buildings located throughout the county.
- 2. The County reserves the right to accept or reject any or all proposals, to waive irregularities and technicalities, and request re-submission. The County reserves the right to award the contract to the lowest responsible proposer submitting a responsive proposal meets the specifications
- 3. The contractor shall be responsible for the all labor, material, equipment and supervision necessary to provide the required services. The contractor shall guarantee that all persons applying pesticides are certified and have the appropriate license as described in the Specification section of this document.
- 4. All damages to county property, caused by the successful vendor's equipment or employees will be the responsibility of the successful vendor. All repairs to such damages are the successful vendor's responsibility after approval from County Building Maintenance Supervisor pertaining to materials and methods used for repairs.
- 5. The contract period is for two (2) years starting <u>JANUARY 1, 2015 ending DECEMBER 31, 2016.</u>

6. VISITATION OF COUNTY FACILITIES:

Each bidder is required to visit each County facility under this contract to totally familiarize himself/herself with the buildings and areas involved in the pest control service. The prices submitted are to be as indicated on the Proposal Form. Appointments for visiting facilities must be made with maintenance supervisor at each facility.

- Proposers are to bid ALL of the locations. Award will be made to ONE vendor with the lowest TOTAL PROPOSAL PRICE for all locations.
- 8. The County WILL NOT PAY additional service or delivery charges such as "FUEL SUR-CHARGES".

9. PREVAILING WAGES:

All vendors submitting bids are required to conform to all current NYS prevailing wage laws. The County has included a copy of the most current prevailing wage rates as of the printing of this document. However, this has been done as a reference only. The vendor is responsible for complying with all current labor rates and regulations throughout the duration of any contract resulting from this document. Current rates are available by calling the NYS Department of Labor at (585) 258-4505. Rates are also available via the internet at:

The County will only pay and the vendor agrees to only charge prevailing wage rates to those employees of any organization that are required by New York State law to receive said rates in the course doing work for the County of Cattaraugus.

The contractor agrees to verify all rates with the New York State Department of Labor prior to submitting a proposal and prior to doing any work for the County as well as to establish which of the those workers involved in any part of a contract for the County are required by law to receive said rates.

NOTE: Vendors currently on the NYS Labor Department Debarred list will not be considered for award of this contract. By submitting a proposal for consideration, the vendor is indicating to the County that they are currently in good standing with the NYS Department of Labor at the time of the proposal

TERMINATION AT WILL:

The County reserves the right to terminate any contract resulting from this proposal with (10) ten calendar days written notice to the vendor. The County agrees to show cause and allow the vendor the opportunity to rectify problems. However, if in the sole opinion of the County, the vendor has not resolved or shown a good faith effort to rectify the problem to the satisfaction of the County in a timely and workman like manner, said contract shall be terminated and the County shall take whatever actions are allowed by New York State General Municipal Law.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

Provide monthly, semi-annually or as needed maintenance of various Cattaraugus County Buildings including the
treatment (use of spray and/or bait) of any and all forms of insects and rodents inside and/or outside the facilities.
Some of the facilities will include kitchen and eating areas. Each facility is to be invoiced separately. A breakdown of
buildings and requirements is found on the proposal form attached.

A service report is to be sent after each treatment to the contact person listed for that building. <u>A report shall be gaven</u> to the Administrator of the two Pine Healthcare and Rehabilitation Centers (Olean & Machias) at time of treatment <u>before leaving the facilities</u>. All maintenance shall be performed during regular business hours; Monday through Friday from 8 AM until 5 PM.

Service to include but not limited to:

- A) Inspect the food serving and food storage areas for the presence of insects/rodents, and treat as necessary.
- B) Inspect all other interior areas of the buildings for insects and rodents; provide treatment and control. The vendor will include with the proposal a list of any additional services, mechanical devices and specialty products not included in monthly service fee and will itemize costs of such services, mechanical devices, and specialty services.
- C) Inspect exterior of the buildings for possible bee nests, other insect problems and entry ports for insect and rodents and treat as necessary.
- D) Both of the Pines Healthcare and Rehabilitation Centers; 2245 West State Street, Olean, NY 14760, and Route 16, Machias, NY 14101, shall have <u>three (3) Indoor/Outdoor treatments</u> <u>One in the spring, one in the summer, and one in the fall</u>, to be coordinated with the maintenance supervisor of that particular facility as to the exact date.
- 2. Special projects may be required for various facilities <u>as needed</u>. These projects would include cluster fly treatment (with Demon W/P) AND rodents. The various facilities and requirements are listed on the proposal form attached.
- 3. Non-covered/Emergency services B Please quote hourly rates for weekdays, weeknights, weekends, and holidays. Required response time: The contractor shall be on site within (4) four hours of the request for emergency services.
- 4. Provide and Install EPA approved Protecta (or equal) outside bait stations with anchors, if requested by the contact person. This shall be for any of the listed locations and outlying buildings at these locations (including Gazebos).
- 5. Provide the County with Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) for all products used upon award of contract.

LICENSE

<u>All</u> persons who apply pesticides must be a certified applicator and are to have the appropriate N.Y.S. D.E.C. licensing. A list of all personnel who will be applying the pesticide and their individual license number MUST BE SUBMITTED with your proposal or the proposal WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.

TRAVEL, EQUIPMENT, AND MATERIAL CHARGES

All pricing must include any travel charges, along with all equipment and materials need to safely and effectively complete the services. No additional up-charges will be allowed.
