Ice/ Cold Water Rescue Technician

This course provides an advanced level ice rescue training including self-rescue, shore based ice rescue techniques, and go ice rescue techniques. This is a hands-on training program which includes a significant amount of on ice time for skill practice. It also addresses the effects of cold water on victims, ice rescue techniques, off shore techniques, and ice rescue equipment. Course will include several scenario based ice rescue exercises.

Requirements: Although there are no "prerequisites", this class is designed for members of FDs that participate in ice/ cold water rescue operations and have appropriate equipment for such rescues. Students should be fit and able to perform such skills and are asked to bring their ice/ cold water rescue suits and equipment to class for use during the scenario practice. - HazMat 1st Responder Ops
- CPR Certification and First Aid

"Basic" Trained Firefighters must have completed the following courses to meet the equivalent of the Firefighter I course:

- Basic Firefighter
- Intermediate Firefighter
- HazMat 1st Responder Ops
- CPR Certification and First Aid
