#### Hazardous Materials First Responder Operations (HMFRO)

Instructor: Will Smith

Location: Little Valley Fire Dept.

**Class Dates and Times:** April 22 & 25 at 18:00 April 27 from 08:00 - 16:00

Prerequisites: None

**NOTES:** Anyone that plans to take Basic Exterior Firefighting Operations (BEFO) or Interior Firefighting Operations (IFO) this year, is highly recommended to take HMFRO prior to the start of the BEFO or IFO course. Preference will be given to students that have already taken HMFRO.

\*\*Additionally, HMFRO is the minimum training, required by OSHA and outlined in the OFPC Best Practices document, to respond to fire calls, therefore all fire department members should have this course before responding.

#### **Decontamination Training**

Instructor: Chautauqua County Location: Cattaraugus County Emergency Operations Center (County Center Building in Little Valley, park/ enter from back lot)

Class Dates and Times: May 1 from 18:00 - 22:00

Prerequisites: None

Operations level course provides responders with knowledge and skills required to conduct Electrostatic Decontamination Tactics (EDT). EDT uses an electrostatic sprayer to add an electric charge to the decon solution. The charged decon droplets will envelop and adhere to the target. The result is the ability to perform a more effective decon for a wide range of incidents with significantly less decon set up.

- HazMat 1st Responder Ops
- CPR Certification and First Aid

"Basic" Trained Firefighters must have completed the following courses to meet the equivalent of the Firefighter I course:

- · Basic Firefighter
- Intermediate Firefighter
- HazMat 1st Responder Ops
- CPR Certification and First Aid

#### Scene Support / BEFO Equivalents

Equivalents are higher levels of training such as IFO, Firefighter 1, Essentials, or Basic Firefighter
