Decontamination Training

Instructor: Chautauqua County

Location: Cattaraugus County Emergency Operations Center (County Center Building in Little Valley, park/ enter from back lot)

Prerequisites: None

Operations level course provides responders with knowledge and skills required to conduct Electrostatic Decontamination Tactics (EDT). EDT uses an electrostatic sprayer to add an electric charge to the decon solution. The charged decon droplets will envelop and adhere to the target. The result is the ability to perform a more effective decon for a wide range of incidents with significantly less decon set up.

Scene Support / BEFO Equivalents

Equivalents are higher levels of training such as IFO, Firefighter 1, Essentials, or Basic Firefighter
