### OPPOSING ASSEMBLY BILL A.9911 REGARDING DOCUMENT PUBLICATION

Pursuant to Section 153 of the County Law.

- I. WHEREAS, Assembly Bill No. A.9911 has been introduced in the NYS Assembly, and
- II. WHEREAS, Assembly Bill No. A.9911 proposes to require all counties, cities, towns and villages make available to the public records, including any proposed resolution, law, rule, regulation, policy or any amendment thereto, that are scheduled to be the subject of discussion by a public body during an open meeting, to the extent practicable, prior to, or at, the meeting during which such records will be discussed, and
- III. WHEREAS, the Bill proposes that the aforementioned records shall be posted on the website of the agency with which the public body is affiliated, as soon as practicable, but not less than twenty-four (24) hours prior to a meeting during which they will be discussed, and copies of such records shall be made available, to the extent practicable, at, or prior to, the meeting, and
- IV. WHEREAS, the aforementioned proposed legislation would cause a significant burden on staff and resources at the local government level, let alone would cost counties, cities, towns and villages more money to make additional copies and to expand their technology to accommodate such requirements, and
- V. WHEREAS, Cattaraugus County has several dozen committees and boards that this new law would affect, and
- VI. WHEREAS, Cattaraugus County also consists of municipalities that do not have internet capability, therefore requiring them to make paper copies available and causing additional expenses for those municipalities, now, therefore, be it
- I. RESOLVED, that the Cattaraugus County Legislature hereby opposes Assembly Bill No. A.9911 for the reasons stated above, and be it further
- II. RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Legislature is hereby directed to forward a certified copy of this resolution to Senator Young, Assembly Member Giglio, the New York State Association of Counties, and the Western New York Inter-County Association.
