GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE UNDER THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT

I. Authority.

This Grievance Procedure complies with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 ("ADA") and has been adopted by the County of Cattaraugus to provide prompt and equitable resolution of disability discrimination complaints that are prohibited by Title II of the ADA. Any individual may file a complaint alleging discrimination of a disabled individual regarding services, programs, or activities provided by the County of Cattaraugus.

II. Designation of Responsible Person.

III. Complaint.

 - 3. Description of the alleged discrimination including the date, location, and facts;

 - 5. List of witnesses who can provide information supporting the complaint.

If the complainant is unable to complete the form and does not have anyone to assist with completing the form, then the complainant shall notify the ADA Coordinator who will provide appropriate alternative means to complete the form such as personal interviews, tape recordings, or larger font.

IV. Filing the Complaint.

- A. The complaint should be filed as soon as possible, but no later than sixty (60) calendar days, after the date of the alleged discrimination.

V. <u>Investigation.</u>

The ADA Coordinator, or a designee, shall mail a hearing notice to the complainant, by way of the United States Postal Service certified mail with return receipt requested and regular mail, to the address indicated on the complaint form, no later than fifteen (15) working days after the date of which the complaint form was filed or postmarked.
- B. The hearing shall be scheduled no later than thirty (30) working days after the date of which the complaint form was filed or postmarked. This deadline may be extended upon show of good cause.

- C. Auxiliary aids and services required to ensure effective communication will be provided upon request. The request must be made to the ADA Coordinator at least five (5) working days before the scheduled hearing to ensure availability.
- D. The complainant must present all evidence including photographs at the time of the scheduled hearing (photographs will not be returned).
 - E. All witnesses must be present at the time of the scheduled hearing.
 - F. Affidavits or notarized statements are not acceptable substitutes for live testimony.
 - G. The hearing shall be recorded using an audio device.

VI. Response.

- A. No later than fifteen (15) working days after the date of the hearing, the ADA Coordinator shall submit a written response to the complainant, in a format accessible to the complainant, by way of the United States Postal Service certified mail with return receipt requested and regular mail, to the address indicated on the complaint form.
- B. The written response shall explain the position of the County of Cattaraugus and offer options for substantive resolution of the complaint.
 - C. The deadline may be extended upon show of good cause.

VII. Appeal.

- A. If the response by the ADA Coordinator does not satisfactorily resolve the issue, the complainant may appeal the ADA Coordinator's decision to the County Administrator or his/her designee no later than thirty (30) working days after the postmark date of the response.

REQUESTING FEDERAL GOVERNMENT TO CHANGE INCOME THRESHOLD ON TAX ON SOCIAL SECURITY INCOME

Pursuant to Section 153 of the County Law.

- I. WHEREAS, Social Security was one of the greatest successes of the 20th century creating a critical foundation of income for retired and disabled workers, and
- II. WHEREAS, for one-third of Americans over the age of 65, Social Security benefits constitute 90% of their total income, and

WHEREAS, in 1984, the federal government enacted legislation (26 U.S.C.§86) taxing social security income for the first time, establishing income thresholds of \$25,000 for single persons and \$32,000 for married couples, which resulted in those individuals with "base income" (adjusted gross income plus one-half of the social security benefits) over these thresholds paying income tax on 50% of their social security benefits, and
- IV. WHEREAS, in 1994, the federal government enacted legislation establishing additional income thresholds for single persons of \$34,000 and married couples of \$44,000, which resulted in those individuals with "base income" over these thresholds paying income tax on 85% of their social security benefits, and
- V. WHEREAS, these income thresholds have not been changed to keep up with inflation and the devaluation of the dollar (27 years for the 50% assessment and 17 years for the 85% assessment), and
- VI. WHEREAS, the Consumer Price Index (U.S. City Average) was at 103.9 in 1984, 149.7 in 1994 and is at 226.76 as of October, 2011, representing an increase of over 87 percent in consumer prices over that time period, and
- VII. WHEREAS, seniors, most of whom live on fixed incomes including social security and pension benefits, have been victimized by the federal government because the taxation of their social security benefits does not reflect the significant annual increase in cost of living, rendering many seniors unable to pay their bills, now, therefore, be it

A LOCAL LAW CHANGING THE DATE OF BUDGET SUBMISSION BY THE BUDGET OFFICER

BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature of the County of Cattaraugus as follows:

SECTION 1. Legislative Intent. The development of a County budget is the most important undertaking of the County Legislature. The Legislature should have more time than currently available to study the recommendations of the Budget Officer, prior to adoption of the County Budget.

SECTION 2. Budget Submission Date. Commencing with the 2012 County budget, the Budget Officer is hereby required to file the tentative budget and budget message with the Clerk of the County Legislature on or before October 15.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Local Law shall take effect August 1, 2012.
