ACT NO. 263-2012 by Mr. Marsh

DECLARING MAY 23, 2012 TO BE "MAYDAY FOR MANDATE RELIEF" AND URGING MANDATE RELIEF COUNCIL TO TAKE SWIFT ACTION IN SUBMITTING PACKAGE OF MANDATE RELIEF PROPOSALS TO GOVERNOR CUOMO AND STATE LEGISLATURE TO BE VOTED ON THIS SESSION

Pursuant to Section 153 of the County Law.

I. WHEREAS, the State of New York mandates the delivery of State programs using local resources,
causing some counties to dedicate more than 80 percent of their entire budget toward the funding of State mandated
programs and fixed costs, and
II. WHEREAS, the New York State Association of Counties (NYSAC) has identified 9 state mandates that
equal 90% of all county property taxes levied in 2010 (outside of New York City), consuming \$4 billion of \$4.4 billion in
county property taxes levied, and
III. WHEREAS, these mandates include: Medicaid, TANF/Public Assistance Safety Net, Child Welfare
Protective and Preventive Care, Special Education Pre-School, Early Intervention, Probation, Indigent Defense, Youth
Detention and Pensions, and
IV. WHEREAS, these State mandates are the root cause of high county property and sales taxes in New York
and have led to a decline in the delivery of import local services, and
V. WHEREAS, these State-imposed mandates continue to contribute to New York's highest in the nation
local tax burden for residents and businesses, severely damaging New York's ability to attract, create and maintain good
paying jobs, as well as contributing to population losses to other states, and
VI. WHEREAS, when the State enacted a property tax cap in 2011, a Mandate Relief Council was established
to review specific mandates and advance legislative proposals to reduce the statutory and regulatory burden on
municipalities, now, therefore, be it
I. RESOLVED, that Cattaraugus County hereby declares May 23, 2012 to be "Mayday for Mandate Relief"
to demonstrate that the decisions made in Albany have a direct impact on the property tax levy and local community
services here in Cattaraugus County, and be it further
II. RESOLVED, that Cattaraugus County hereby calls on the Mandate Relief Council to take swift action in
submitting a package of Mandate Relief proposals to Governor Cuomo and the State Legislature to be voted on by our
State representatives during the 2012 State legislative session, and be it further
III. RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Legislature is hereby directed to forward copies of this resolution to
Governor Andrew M. Cuomo, Senator Young, Assembly Member Giglio, New York State Association of Counties and
the Western New York Inter-County Association.
