AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR TO EXECUTE SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT NO. 1 WITH NYSDOT AND AUTHORIZING CATTARAUGUS COUNTY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE FEDERAL-AID PROJECT ADMINISTERED BY THE NYSDOT AND ADJUSTING VARIOUS APPROPRIATION AND REVENUE ACCOUNTS (Great Valley Bridge No. 9 Replacement Project)

Pursuant to Title 23 U.S. Code and Sections 363, 366 and 450 of the County Law.

- I. WHEREAS, a project for the replacement of the Martin Road Bridge over Forks Creek, BIN 3-32173-0, in the Town of Great Valley, Cattaraugus County, PIN 5758.47 (the "Project"), is eligible for funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, as amended, that calls for the apportionment of the costs of such program to be borne at the ratio of 80% Federal funds and 20% Non-Federal funds, and
- II. WHEREAS, the County desires to advance the above project by making a commitment of 100% of the non-federal share of the costs of the Preliminary Engineering (Design I-VI) and Right-of-Way (Incidentals and Acquisition) phases of the Project, PIN 5758.47, now, therefore, be it
- I. RESOLVED, that the Cattaraugus County Legislature hereby approves the above-described project, and be it further
- II. RESOLVED, that the Cattaraugus County Legislature hereby authorizes the County of Cattaraugus to pay in the first instance 100% of the Federal and Non-Federal shares of the cost of the Preliminary Engineering (Design I-VI) and Right-of-Way (Incidentals and Acquisition) phases of the Project, or portions thereof, and be it further
- III. RESOLVED, that the sum of \$64,200.00 is hereby appropriated, in addition to \$205,000.00 previously appropriated via County Resolution No. 422-2008 adopted on August 27, 2008, and made available to cover the cost of participation in the Preliminary Engineering (Design I-VI) and Right-of-Way (Incidentals and Acquisition) phases of the Project, and be it further
- IV. RESOLVED, that in the event the amount required to pay 100% of the full Federal and Non-Federal shares of the cost of the project's Preliminary Engineering (Design I-VI) and Right-of-Way (Incidentals and Acquisition) phases exceeds the amount appropriated \$269,200.00, the County of Cattaraugus shall convene its Legislature as soon as possible to appropriate said excess amount immediately upon the notification by the NYSDOT thereof, and be it further
- V. RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Legislature be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to execute all necessary documents, on behalf of Cattaraugus County, with the NYSDOT in connection with the advancement or approval of the Project and providing for the administration of the Project and the municipality's first instance funding of Project costs and permanent funding of the local share of federal-aid and state-aid eligible Project costs and all Project costs within appropriations therefor that are not so eligible, and be it further

LOCAL LAW NUMBER 10 - 2012 COUNTY OF CATTARAUGUS, NEW YORK

Pursuant to Section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law and Articles 9 and 13 of the Real Property Tax Law.

A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING THAT THE COUNTY OF CATTARAUGUS SHALL BECOME THE TAX COLLECTION AGENCY FOR THE PURPOSE OF COLLECTING TAXES AND SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS IN INSTALLMENTS

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislature of the County of Cattaraugus as follows:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Intent. It is the intent of this Local Law that on and after the effective date of this Local Law, and until such time as this Local Law is repealed, the County of Cattaraugus shall become the tax collection agency for the purpose of collecting taxes in installments as prescribed by Article 9, Title 4-A and by Article 13 of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> Definitions. The term "taxes", as used in this Local Law, shall include special assessments which are levied by the County Legislature at the time and in the manner provided by law for the levy of county and town taxes.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> Installments. Such taxes may be paid in two equal installments, the first of which shall be due and payable not later than the fifteenth day of the month in which the respective taxes may be paid without interest to the local Receiver or Collector of Taxes without regard to this Local Law. The second installment shall be due and payable not later than the first day of the sixth month thereafter to the County Treasurer of the County of Cattaraugus.

SECTION 4. Service Charge. There shall be a service charge of 2 ½ percent of the amount of taxes as levied which it is estimated will reimburse the County for the expense incurred in the administration of the installment collection of taxes as prescribed by this Local Law, including the cost of contracting any necessary indebtedness for the purpose of advancing to towns and school districts installments to become due in the future, as provided in Real Property Tax Law \$976 and 1342, respectively. If in any year the estimated service charge is not sufficient to reimburse the County for administering and financing the collection of taxes in installments as provided in this Local Law, the amount of such deficiency shall be included in determining the estimated service charge for the collection of taxes for the succeeding year by resolution of the Cattaraugus County Legislature pursuant to Real Property Tax Law Section 972, Subsection 3. The amount of such service charge shall be added to the first installment of the taxes which an owner of real property may have elected to pay in installments pursuant to the provisions of this Local Law, and such service charge shall be deemed part of such taxes. The amount of such charge and any interest which shall be added to any installment pursuant to the provisions of this Local Law shall belong to the County.

SECTION 5. Real Property Tax Law.

(a) On and after the effective date of this Local Law, the town board of any town may determine, in accordance with Section 973 of the Real Property Tax Law, that thereafter and until such action be duly rescinded, the amount of taxes for county, town and special district purposes constituting in the aggregate an amount in excess of \$50.00 levied by the County Legislature pursuant to law upon any parcel of real property situate within such town, may be paid in installments as provided herein.

- (b) Notwithstanding any of the provisions of the Real Property Tax Law or any other general, special or local law to the contrary, on and after the effective date of this Local Law the school authorities of a school district within the County of Cattaraugus may determine, in accordance with Section 1336 of the Real Property Tax Law, that thereafter and until such action be duly rescinded, any taxes in excess of \$50.00 levied by it upon any parcel of real property within Cattaraugus County situated within the school district, may be paid in installments as provided herein.
- (c) Whenever a resolution has been adopted pursuant to this section, the notice required to be given by the collecting officer pursuant to Sections 920 and 1322 of the Real Property Tax Law shall state that taxes may be paid in installments as provided by this Local Law. Warrants for the collection of taxes levied while such resolution continues in force shall contain appropriate directions for the collection of taxes in the manner specified by this Local Law.

SECTION 6. Statement of Taxes.

- (a) Upon receipt of the tax roll and warrant, the collecting officer shall mail to each property owner of property listed thereon, a statement of taxes as provided by law.
- (b) Such statement shall recite that such owner may elect, pursuant to Section 7 of this Local Law, to pay the taxes set forth in the statement in installments, as provided herein.

SECTION 7. Payment.

- (a) Upon receipt of the statement of taxes, an owner of real property may elect to pay the total amount of the taxes set forth in such statement without regard to this Local Law; or he may elect to pay such taxes in installments as provided herein.
- (b) If such owner shall elect to pay the taxes in installments, he shall pay to the collecting officer the amount set forth in such statement and designated as "first installment", which amount shall include the service charge set forth in Section 4 of this Local Law. The amount of the second installment shall be paid to the County Treasurer on or before the date specified in Section 3 of this Local Law.
- (c) If any such installment is paid on or before the date when due, no interest shall be charged thereon; if not so paid, interest shall be added to the amount of any such installment at the rate as determined pursuant to Section 924-a of the Real Property Tax Law. No such installment may be paid unless all prior installments of current taxes, including interest, shall have been paid or shall be paid at the same time.
- (d) The owner of real property who elects to pay taxes in installments as provided in this Section shall indicate his election by remitting the amount of the first installment to the collecting officer on or before the date upon which it is due or not later than within five days thereafter; provided, however, that in the event the amount of the first installment is paid after the date upon which it was due, the interest rate set forth in subdivision (c) of this Section shall apply.
- (e) The failure or neglect by an owner of real property to pay the first installment as provided in subdivision (d) of this Section shall be construed as an election by such owner to pay the total amount of taxes in one payment in the manner provided by law.
- <u>SECTION 8.</u> Powers and <u>Duties.</u> The County Treasurer of the County of Cattaraugus is hereby empowered to promulgate and amend suitable rules and regulations prescribing the necessary forms for carrying into effect the provision of this Local Law relating to the installment payment of taxes.

<u>SECTION 9.</u> Severability. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity or circumstance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, effect or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this law or in its application to the person, individual corporation, firm, partnership, entity or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which such order or judgment shall be rendered.

SECTION 10. Effective Date. This Local Law shall become effective January 1, 2014.
