- I. WHEREAS, the Gowanda Area Revitalization Corporation, 13437 Quaker Street, Collins, New York 14034, has requested funds to continue the final phases of restoring the former Peter Cooper Superfund Site to a usable property, and
- II. WHEREAS, the overall project will result in a recreational park positioned on Cattaraugus Creek, which will serve as the gateway to the State-owned Zoar Valley Multiple Use Area and conservation site, and
- III. WHEREAS, the project shall include the installation of active sports fields and playground, restroom facilities, concession stands and a non-motorized trail, and
- IV. WHEREAS, the County shall make available an amount of \$203,952.00, to be made in periodic payments approved by the County Administrator, to assist with the construction of the Zoar Valley Gateway Park, and
- V. WHEREAS, a contract is necessary with the Gowanda Area Revitalization Corporation, and
- VI. WHEREAS, the aforementioned amount of \$203,952.00 shall be provided to the Gowanda Area Revitalization Corporation through Casino funds, and
- VII. WHEREAS, various appropriation and revenue accounts must be adjusted in order to accommodate the aforementioned \$203,952.00, now, therefore, be it

- I. WHEREAS, Gowanda's Historic Hollywood Theater, Ltd., P.O. Box 164, 3910 Main Street, Gowanda, New York 14070, which is a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization, is requesting funding to assist with Phase IV of a multi-phase historic restoration project, and

 II. WHEREAS, Phase IV of the restoration project will address engineering and the retro-fit of a 1926 truss in preparation for the replacement of air handling units, flat and ornate plaster work, testing, cleaning and painting of ceiling surfaces, placement of HVAC duct work, dry storage area and the replacement of metal exit stairs, and
- III. WHEREAS, the re-opening of the historic theater will create jobs, encourage heritage tourism and potentially mold the economic future of this rural tri-county area, and
- IV. WHEREAS, the assistance received from the County will also allow the Gowanda's Historic Hollywood Theater, Ltd., to leverage additional grant funding, and
- V. WHEREAS, the County shall make available an amount of \$104,388.00, to be made in periodic payments approved by the County Administrator, to assist with the aforementioned project, and
- VI. WHEREAS, a contract is necessary with the Gowanda's Historic Hollywood Theater, Ltd., and
- VII. WHEREAS, the aforementioned \$104,388.00 shall be provided to Gowanda's Historic Hollywood Theater, Ltd., through Casino funds, and

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AUTHORIZING COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE CONTRACT WITH EMPLOYEE SERVICES, INC., FOR EMPLOYEE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Pursuant to Section 205 of the County Law and Act 290-2011, as amended, of the Cattaraugus County Legislature.

WHEREAS, Act 611-2012, authorized a contract with Employee Services, Inc., 111 West Pearl Street,

- Wellsville, New York 14895, for the provision of an Employee Assistance Program, the term of which expires December 31, 2013, and

 II. WHEREAS, Employee Services, Inc. has advised the County that a new rate of \$26.00 per non-public safety employee and \$38.47 per public safety employee will be charged effective January 1, 2014, for a total not to exceed \$24,354.00, based on the number of covered employees, and

 III. WHEREAS, the total number of covered employees may increase or decrease up to, and including, five percent without *effecting affecting* the total value of the agreement, and

 IV. WHEREAS, if the number of covered employees increases or decreases by more than five percent, then the total agreement value may be revised quarterly to reflect the changes in employees covered, now, therefore, be it
- I. RESOLVED, that the County Administrator be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to execute a contract, contingent upon and subject to the inclusion in the 2014 budget of sufficient funds to cover the costs of the aforementioned services, on behalf of Cattaraugus County, with Employee Services, Inc., for the provision of the above-described services, for a term commencing January 1, 2014 and terminating December 31, 2014, according to the above-described terms.
