- I. WHEREAS, Act 479-2012 authorized contracts with the New York State Department of Health and Health Research, Inc., in order to accept the Community Transformation Grant–Small Communities funding by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and
- II. WHEREAS, the Department of Health is in need of advertising services for programs and services provided through the Community Transformation Grant, and

- II. RESOLVED, that upon termination of either state or federal funding for this program, then this program shall be automatically abolished, and be it further
- III. RESOLVED, that the Chairman is hereby further authorized, without further act of the Legislature, to execute such documents as may be required to indicate the County's consent to the assignment of such contract by Time Warner Cable to Comcast Corporation or any division, subsidiary or affiliate thereof, including a new contract with such entity replacing the contract with Time Warner Cable hereby authorized
- **##.IV** RESOLVED, that such contract shall provide that upon the reduction of any such funding, the County, in its sole discretion, may terminate the contract on thirty (30) days written notice, and be it further
- RESOLVED, that in the event of any such reduction, the department head involved shall immediately report such occurrence to the Chairman of the Committee to which the department is assigned, who shall add the matter to the agenda of the Committee's next meeting.
