Pursuant to Section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

**A LOCAL LAW REPEALING LOCAL LAW NUMBER 23-2003 (INTRO NO. 25-2003),
ENTITLED "A LOCAL LAW AUTHORIZING A SEPARATE LISTING IN EACH
REAL PROPERTY TAX STATEMENT, SHOWING THE MEDICAID PORTION OR
OTHER NEW YORK STATE IMPOSED MANDATES AFFECTING COUNTY TAXES"**

BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature of the County of Cattaraugus as follows:

Section 1. Local Law Number 23-2003 (Intro No. 25-2003), entitled, "A Local Law Authorizing a Separate Listing in each Real Property Tax Statement, Showing the Medicaid Portion or Other New York State Imposed Mandates Affecting County Taxes", is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Effective Date.

The local law shall become effective immediately.

Pursuant to Section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law and
Sections 201 and 205 of the County Law.

**A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING SALARIES FOR CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICERS
FOR THE YEARS 2014 AND 2015**

BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature of the County of Cattaraugus as follows:

SECTION 1. Legislative Intent. It is the intent of this Local Law to establish salaries for County Officers, elected or appointed who serve fixed terms, for the years 2014 and 2015.

SECTION 2. Schedule of 2014 Salaries. Effective January 1, 2014, the County Officers listed below shall receive the following bi-weekly salary, which represents their allocated portion of an additional 2% salary increase for 2014 which has been distributed among Department Heads by the methodology established under Act 184-2009 entitled, "Establishing Position Value System for Associating Department Head and Legislative Appointment Salary Increases to Performance Based System":

SECTION 5. Supercession. All local laws and resolutions of the Cattaraugus County Legislature, including without limitation Local Law Number 5-2008 and Act No. 184-2009, to the extent that the same are inconsistent with this local law, are hereby superceded.

SECTION 6. Effective Date. This Local Law is subject to permissive referendum in accordance with Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
