AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR TO EXECUTE SUPPLEMENTAL CONTRACT NO. 1 WITH NYSDOT FOR CONSTRUCTION AND CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION SERVICES FOR BRIDGE OPEN STEEL DECK FEDERAL-AID REPLACEMENT PROJECT AND ADJUSTING VARIOUS APPROPRIATION AND REVENUE ACCOUNTS (Department of Public Works)

Pursuant to Title 23 U.S. Code and Sections 363, 366 and 450 of the County Law.

- I. WHEREAS, Act 344-2013 authorized a contract with NYSDOT for participation in the Cattaraugus County Bridge Open Steel Deck Replacement Project, including seven (7) bridges, in various towns in Cattaraugus County, PIN 5760.78 (the "Project"), and
- II. WHEREAS, the Project is eligible for funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, as amended, that calls for the apportionment of the costs of such program to be borne at a ratio of 80% federal funds and 20% non-federal funds, and
- III. WHEREAS, the County desires to advance the Project by making a commitment of 100% of the non-federal share of the costs of the Preliminary Engineering (Design I-VI) and Construction & Construction Inspection phases of the Project, PIN 5760.78, and
- IV. WHEREAS, budgetary adjustments must made to appropriate this funding, now, therefore, be it
 I. RESOLVED, that the Cattaraugus County Legislature hereby approves the above-described
 Project, and be it further
- II. RESOLVED, that the Cattaraugus County Legislature hereby authorizes the County of Cattaraugus to pay in the first instance 100% of the federal and non-federal shares of the cost of the Preliminary Engineering (Design I-VI) and Construction & Construction Inspection phases of the Project or portions thereof, and be it further
- III. RESOLVED, that the sum of \$220,000.00 is hereby appropriated, in addition to \$100,000.00 previously appropriated for the project's Preliminary Engineering (Design I-VI) phase via County Resolution No. 344-2013 adopted on August 28, 2013, and made available to cover the cost of participation in the above phase of the Project, and be it further
- IV. RESOLVED, that in the event the amount required to pay the full federal and non-federal shares of the cost of the Project's Preliminary Engineering (Design I-VI) and Construction & Construction Inspection phases exceeds the amount appropriated, \$320,000.00, and/or 100% of the full federal and non-federal shares of the cost of the Preliminary Engineering (Design I-VI) and Construction & Construction Inspection phases exceeds \$1,200,000, the project's current Total Cost, the County of Cattaraugus shall convene its Legislature as soon as possible to appropriate said excess amount immediately upon the notification by the NYSDOT, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Legislature be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to execute all necessary documents, on behalf of Cattaraugus County, with the NYSDOT in connection with the advancement or approval of the Project and providing for the administration of the Project and the municipality's first instance funding of Project costs and permanent funding of the local share of federal-aid Project costs and all Project costs within appropriations therefor that are not so eligible, and be it further VI.
