RECREATING CATTARAUGUS COUNTY EQUINE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

I. WHEREAS, Act 464-2011 created the Cattaraugus County Equine Advisory Committee as a result
of the Cattaraugus County Department of Economic Development, Planning and Tourism (EDP&T) completing
an economic development strategy for all economic sectors in the Route 219 highway corridor and for
communities in the perimeter zones of the Allegany State Park, which expires December 31, 2014, and
II. WHEREAS, the EDP&T has also completed the Allegany State Park Perimeter Study by
authorizing three guidebooks which present findings and recommendations for promoting the (1)
equine/equestrian economy, (2) trails, and (3) villages, as implementation tools for these special elements of
the County's overall economic development strategy, and
III. WHEREAS, these three guidebooks are called (1) Saving Our Villages (Volume 3, December 30,
2004); (2) Growing the Equestrian Economy in Cattaraugus County, New York (Volume 8, March 11, 2005); and
(3) A New Vision for Outdoor Recreation Trails in Cattaraugus County, New York (Volume 4, November 16,
2005), and
IV. WHEREAS, Cattaraugus County's economic development strategy and these implementation
guidebooks are designed to test regional economic markets for specific projects and locations in a countywide
context, and
V. WHEREAS, the County is desirous of continuing a long-term implementation process to bring
the aforementioned recommendations to fruition in the next decade, and
VI. WHEREAS, the citizen's advisory committee should continue in order to continue to review and
refine these recommendations, especially to recognize and promote the equine/equestrian community in
Cattaraugus County and to advise the Cattaraugus County Legislature's Development and Agriculture
Committee and EDP&T accordingly, now, therefore, be it
I. RESOLVED, that effective January 1, 2015, the Cattaraugus County Equine Advisory Committee
is hereby recreated, and be it further
II. RESOLVED, that the purpose of the Committee shall be as stated above, and be it further
III. RESOLVED, that the Committee shall consist of eighteen (18) members to be appointed by the
Chair of the County Legislature from the equine/equestrian community, the private sector, the New York State
Horse Council, and Cattaraugus County government, and be it further
IV. RESOLVED, that the committee shall terminate on December 31, 2017.
