- I. RESOLVED, that the Cattaraugus County Legislature hereby respectfully requests Governor Cuomo to instruct Commissioner Driscall to apply for Nationally Significant Freight and Highway Projects (NSFHP) Program Funding for the completion of Route 219 Section 12, and be it further
- II. RESOLVED, that the Cattaraugus County Legislature hereby respectfully requests Governor Cuomo coordinate with Commissioner Driscall to commit the necessary matching funds for the study and construction needs of the Route 219 project, and be it further
- III. RESOLVED, that \$20 million in State funds for a \$100 million project is critical to the economic viability of Cattaraugus County, and be it further
- IV. RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Legislature shall forward copies of this resolution to Governor Andrew M. Cuomo, the Majority Leader of the NYS Senate, Senators Young and Gallivan, the Speaker of the NYS Assembly, Assemblyman Giglio, the NYS Commissioner of Transportation, and all others deemed necessary and proper.
