A LOCAL LAW AMENDING LOCAL LAW NO. 22-2003 (INTRO NUMBER 21-2003) REGARDING FEES FOR PROCESSING CERTAIN TAX TITLE PROPERTY

BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature of the County of Cattaraugus as follows: Legislative Intent. The purpose of this local law is to amend Local Law No. 22-2003 (Intro No. Section 1. 21-2003) entitled "A Local Law Establishing Fees for Processing Certain Tax Title Property and Repealing Local Law Number 10-1991 (Intro Number 12-1991)" to establish fees for various departments for the processing of returning tax title property to former owners by legislative resolution and deed after foreclosure. Section 2. Amendment. Local Law No. 22-2003 (Intro No. 21-2003) shall be amended as follows: Delete Section 2. Processing Fees, and replace with the following: "Section 2. Processing Fees. 2.1 Effective January 1, 2017, any property which is sold to the former owner without competitive bidding shall be subject to a processing fee of \$1,100 to be allocated as follows: County Attorney's Office - \$800; County Treasurer's Office - \$200; Real Property Tax Service Agency - \$100." Severability. If any provision of this local law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, then such adjudication, shall not effect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the particular provision directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.
