I. WHEREAS, Cattaraugus County owns and, through its Department of Nursing Homes, operates The Pines Healthcare and Rehabilitation Center - Olean Campus, and

II. WHEREAS, the County continues to receive Inter-Governmental Transfer ("IGT") payments from the federal government to offset the operation of the Nursing Home, and

III. WHEREAS, The Pines Healthcare and Rehabilitation Center - Olean Campus ended fiscal year 2015 with a deficit of \$953,616.45, which included IGT payments from the federal government in the amount of \$1,639,633.00, and

IV. WHEREAS, it is expected that IGT payments to the County will gradually diminish and be replaced by Managed Care, causing a further significant deficit in the operation of the facility, and

V. WHEREAS, while recognizing the continuing need that well-operated skilled nursing homes be available in the future to the residents of Cattaraugus County, the Legislature is considering several options for the continued operation of the facilities, including the possibility that the facility be offered for sale to a privately-owned entity, and

VI. WHEREAS, in order to properly assess the available options, the Legislature must identify private entities which are interested in purchasing The Pines Healthcare and Rehabilitation Center - Olean Campus, and the terms of such offers, and

VII. WHEREAS, in order to determine such interest, it is necessary that the Legislature request proposals therefor, and

VIII. WHEREAS, such request shall provide that proposers must guarantee that all current employees of the facility affected will be interviewed for positions of employment equivalent to those which they presently hold, and

IX. WHEREAS, such request shall further provide that adequate arrangements shall be made for the continued care, either at the facility or elsewhere, of all residents of the facility, now, therefore, be it

and Sections 363, 366 and 450 of the County Law.

I. WHEREAS, the New York State Office of Indigent Legal Services has announced that it is accepting proposals for a three-year distribution of funds from the Indigent Legal Services Fund (ILSF) for the period January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2017, and

II. WHEREAS, a three-year plan must be submitted to the Office of Indigent Legal Services which demonstrates that the funding provided will be utilized to improve the quality of legal representation under Article 18-B of the County Law, and

III. WHEREAS, Cattaraugus County has been notified that it shall receive an amount of \$161,466.00 per year for three (3) years, for a total three-year grant in the amount of \$484,398.00 for the period January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2017, and

IV. WHEREAS, the application for the aforementioned funding shall reflect the following proposed uses as have been agreed upon by the Public Defender, the Administrator of Assigned Counsel and Legal Assistance of Western New York, with the approval of the Executive Officer of Cattaraugus County:

COUNTY OF CATTARAUGUS, NEW YORK

Pursuant to Section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law and
Sections 201 and 205 of the County Law.

A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING SALARY FOR PUBLIC DEFENDER

BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature of the County Of Cattaraugus as follows:

SECTION 1. Legislative Intent. It is the intent of this Local Law to establish a salary for the Public Defender.

SECTION 2. Salary. Effective January 1, 2016, the Public Defender shall receive a bi-weekly salary as follows:

2016	\$4,495.67
2017	\$4,720.45
2018	\$4,956.47.

SECTION 4. Supercession. All local laws and resolutions of the Cattaraugus County Legislature, including without limitation Local Law Number 3-2014 and Act No. 205-2014, to the extent that the same are inconsistent with this local law, are hereby superceded.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Local Law is subject to permissive referendum in accordance with Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
