Pursuant to Section 450 of the County Law.

- I. WHEREAS, Act 441-2012 authorized a contract for the provision of podiatry services for the residents of The Pines Healthcare & Rehabilitation Centers, the term of which expires September 30, 2016, and
 II. WHEREAS, the County Department of Nursing Homes is desirous of continuing the aforementioned services, and
- III. WHEREAS, Steven Gutsin, DPM, 41 Bender Drive, Orchard Park, New York 14127, has agreed to provide the aforementioned podiatry services at The Pines Healthcare & Rehabilitation Center Olean and Machias Campuses for an amount of \$3,600 not to exceed \$4,000.00 per facility per year, as follows:

- IV. WHEREAS, sufficient funds are included in the budget to cover the costs of the aforementioned services, now, therefore, be it
- I. RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Legislature be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to execute a contract, on behalf of Cattaraugus County, with Steven Gutsin, DPM, for the provision of the above-described services, for a term commencing October 1, 2016 and terminating September 30, 2018, with the option to renew for two (2) one-year terms at the same rate, according to the above-described terms.

DIRECTING COUNTY TREASURER TO ISSUE CERTIFICATE OF PROSPECTIVE CANCELLATION

Pursuant to Section 1138(6)(d) of the Real Property Tax Law.

I. WHEREAS, there are certain parcels of property on the assessment roll for which there is no practical method to enforce the collection of delinquent tax liens arising hereafter against these parcels, and

- II. WHEREAS, the County Treasurer should issue a certificate of Prospective Cancellation on each parcel, and
- III. WHEREAS, the parcels shall then become exempt from taxation notwithstanding any other provision of law, and shall remain exempt until the County Legislature determines that the parcels should be restored to the taxable portion of the assessment roll, now, therefore, be it
- I. RESOLVED, that the County Treasurer is hereby directed to issue a Certificate of Prospective Cancellation for the following properties:
