LOCAL LAW NUMBER 9 - 2016 COUNTY OF CATTARAUGUS, NEW YORK

Pursuant to Section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law and Sections 201 and 205 of the County Law.

A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING SALARY FOR PUBLIC DEFENDER

BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature of the County Of Cattaraugus as follows:

- <u>SECTION 1.</u> Legislative Intent. It is the intent of this Local Law to establish a salary for the Public Defender.
- <u>SECTION 2.</u> Salary. Effective January 1, 2016, the Public Defender shall receive a bi-weekly salary of \$4,131.01.
- <u>SECTION 3.</u> Supercession. All local laws and resolutions of the Cattaraugus County Legislature, including without limitation Local Law Number 3-2014 and Act No. 205-2014, to the extent that the same are inconsistent with this local law, are hereby superceded.
- <u>SECTION 4.</u> Effective Date. This Local Law is subject to permissive referendum in accordance with Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

Pursuant to 29 USCS 1604 and Section 450 of the County Law.

- I. WHEREAS, Act 656-2015 authorized a contract with Judith Gallegos for the provision of drug/alcohol screening and comprehensive case management for all public assistance adult applicants/recipients, the term of which expires December 31, 2016, and
- II. WHEREAS, the County Department of Social Services is required to provide the aforementioned services pursuant to the Welfare Reform Act of 1996, and
- III.
