IV. WHEREAS, sufficient funds are included in the budget to cover the cost of the aforementioned equipment, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Legislature be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to execute an amended contract, on behalf of Cattaraugus County, with Olean General Healthcare Systems, for the provision of the above-described equipment and services, which amends the contract which commenced October 1, 2013 and terminates September 30, 2017, according to the above-described terms.
