AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR TO APPLY FOR FUNDING THROUGH NEW YORK STATE GOVERNOR'S TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE FOR SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT TRAFFIC SAFETY PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM

Pursuant to Section 1229-c of the Vehicle and Traffic Law and Section 450 of the County Law.

- I. WHEREAS, Act 190-2016 authorized the Chairman to apply for funding through the New York State Governor's Traffic Safety Committee for a Traffic Safety Enforcement Program for the 2016-2017 program year, and
- II. WHEREAS, funding is again available through the New York State Governor's Traffic Safety Committee for Traffic Safety Programs for the 2017-2018 program year, for the following components:

Child Safety Seat Program (for income eligible recipients)
Police Traffic Services
Traffic Safety Education Programs,

and

- III. WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office is desirous of applying for the aforementioned funding, and
- IV. WHEREAS, this program includes funding from the New York State Governor's Traffic Safety Committee, and
- V. WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office shall partner with the County Departments of Social Services and Health for the Child Safety Seat Program, now, therefore, be it
- I.
