**OPPOSING DRIVER'S LICENSE ACCESS AND PRIVACY ACT
(S.01747 and A.03675)**

Pursuant to Section 153 of the County Law.

I. WHEREAS, under existing law, a Social Security number is required in order to obtain a New York State driver's license, and

II. WHEREAS, the Driver's License Access and Privacy Act proposed by Senate Bill S.01747 and Assembly Bill A.03675 (collectively referred to as "the Act") proposes to allow undocumented persons, who are in the United States illegally, to be able obtain a driver's license without having a social security number, green card or visa, and

III. WHEREAS, the adoption of this Act will reward undocumented immigrants who have illegally entered the United States by permitting them to obtain drivers' licenses, and

IV. WHEREAS, adoption of the Act would create serious security risks to the residents of Cattaraugus County and the State of New York, because:

- it does not guarantee that the identity of undocumented individuals could be properly verified by the State of New York, since the Federal government would not have issued a green card or visa;
- driver's licenses could be used by undocumented aliens to obtain additional official identification documents, such as Passports;
- it provides an alert on such licenses that states they are "Not for Federal Purposes"; such alert is in a font so small it will be easily overlooked, allowing the license to be used as legal identification in situations where it is not intended to be used; and
- local DMV Office staff do not have the expertise to determine the authenticity of foreign documents, nor are they provided the tools to do so;

and

V. WHEREAS, the duties of trained Immigration agents would effectively be imposed on local DMV staff, if the Act is adopted, and

VI. WHEREAS, there is no evidence that passage of this Act will make New York State roads safer, now, therefore, be it

I. RESOLVED, that the Cattaraugus County Legislature hereby strongly opposes the adoption of the Driver's License Access and Privacy Act as it concerns the issuance of a license to undocumented individuals, due to the security risks it presents, and on the grounds that it contradicts federal law, and be it further

II. RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Legislature is hereby directed to forward a certified copy of this resolution to Governor Cuomo, Commissioner Schroeder of the New York State Department of Motor Vehicles, Senator Sepúlveda, Majority Leader of the Senate Stewart-Cousins, Assembly Member Giglio, Assembly Member Crespo, Speaker of the Assembly Heastie, Chairman of the Senate Transportation Committee Kennedy, the New York State Association of Counties, and the Western New York Inter-County Association.

LOCAL LAW NUMBER 7 - 2019
COUNTY OF CATTARAUGUS, NEW YORK

A LOCAL LAW REQUIRING CATTARAUGUS COUNTY CLERK TO OBTAIN
COUNTER SIGNATURES FROM CITY OF OLEAN PRIOR TO RECORDING OF DEEDS

Pursuant to Section 10 of the General Municipal Law.

Section 1. Legislative Intent. It is the intent of this local law to require the Cattaraugus County Clerk to obtain a counter signature from the City of Olean on each and every deed conveying real property located within the City of Olean.

Section 2. County Clerk to Obtain Counter Signature. The Cattaraugus County Clerk shall not record any deed, transfer or conveyance of land for property located within the City of Olean, unless such deed contains a counter signature from the City of Olean.

Section 3. Severability. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, or business shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not effect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this law, or in its specific application.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Local Law shall become effective as provided in Municipal Home Rule Law Section 27.
