LOCAL LAW NUMBER 2-2009 COUNTY OF CATTARAUGUS, NEW YORK

Pursuant to Section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

A LOCAL LAW PROHIBITING SMOKING IN AUTOMOBILES WITH CHILDREN PRESENT

 $\,$ BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature of the County of Cattaraugus as follows:

SECTION 1. Legislative Intent and Purpose.

- a. This Legislature finds that it is essential to ensure the welfare of our children by acknowledging the fact that second hand smoke is detrimental to people's health, specifically children who may be unable to avoid second hand smoke inhalation.
- b. This Legislature determines that the best way to avoid the harmful affects of second hand smoke, without restricting the individual rights and freedoms granted under the Constitution of the United States of America, to ban smoking in automobiles, a place where second hand smoke inhalation can be avoided, and where ventilation is insufficient.

SECTION 2. Definitions.

- a. The term "Second hand smoke" shall mean the mixture of the smoke given off by the burning end of a cigarette, pipe, or cigar, and the smoke exhaled from the lungs of smokers.
- b. The term "Children" shall be defined as any person under the age of 16 years.
- c. The term "Automobile" shall mean any engine-bearing machine used for any purpose on public roads.

SECTION 3. Restrictions.

a. No person shall be allowed to smoke while operating or residing as a passenger in an automobile with children present. The operator will be held responsible for any misconduct by a passenger.

SECTION 4. Penalties.

- a. A first violation shall be punishable by a minimum fine of \$200 and a maximum fine of up to \$500, with the second and subsequent violations resulting in a minimum fine of \$500 with a maximum fine of up to \$1,000.
- SECTION 5. Severability. If any provision of this Local Law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, then such adjudication, shall not effect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the particular provision directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.
- SECTION 6. Effective Date. This Local Law shall take effect immediately.
